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
The Soft Landing Arrives


Percent Growth, Real Gross Domestic Product, 2022Q4 – 2024Q4



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




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Commodity Prices Reflect Global Slowdown





Share of retail spending online, %


Share of days worked from home, %







Projects Announced by Projected Employment





The Montana Economy: Anatomy of a Slowdown


- New data depict 2021 as the growth peak



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Wages and Employment, Montana, 2020Q1 – 2023Q2






Growth in Inflation-Corrected Nonfarm Earnings, Selected Montana Counties, 2021 and 2022

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

Net Population Migration, 2011-2023, Montana



Growth in 2023 Air Passenger Volume Was Uneven










Key Industry Outlook: Energy

- U.S. Oil Output Surpasses pre-2020 peak, most new drilling is elsewhere
- Coal has another year of stability, still down 20 percent from pre-2020 production
- Changes at Montana's refineries
- EPA rulemaking clouds future for Montana facilities




Key Industry Outlook: High Tech

- Impact of turbulence in high tech nationally is mixed for Montana companies
- Environment for funding for startups has worsened
- High housing costs have pushed hiring in some instances to other Montana cities
- Universities' position as growth centers strengthened by Headwaters Tech Hub designation
